Where it refuses work

- `AngularParser` stops the work with `Error` when `!this.project` — “Parser not initialized. Call `initialize()` first.”.
- `AngularParser` stops the work with an early return when `!name`, in 4 places.
- `AngularParser` stops the work with an early return when `!this.canParse(filePath)`.

- `AngularParser` stops the work with an early return when `!fileContent.trim()` .
- `AngularParser` stops the work with an early return when `jsDocs.length > 0` .

When something fails

- `AngularParser` handles failure in 1 place: it turns it into a return value in all 1.
