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## GitSyncTrigger

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**Kind:** Class**Source:** `atloria-monorepo/apps/api/src/git-sync/git-sync-trigger.ts`

A dependency-free hop that lets the GitHub App webhook hand a push payload to the `git-sync`

ingest WITHOUT importing `GitSyncModule` — which would create a module cycle (`GithubAppModule` → `GitSyncModule` → `GithubAppModule`). Exactly the `DocsPrTrigger` pattern.

`GitSyncIngestService` registers the real handler on init. If the feature module isn't loaded, `requestPush` is a silent no-op — wiring this into the webhook can never break it.

## Where it refuses work

- `GitSyncTrigger` stops the work with an early return when `!this.handler`.
