The split point is the first sentence end or the first line break, whichever comes first — which is how every doc-comment convention in every language here already reads.

The `description === undefined` case is the important one. `@ApiOperation({ summary: 'Get the current user' })` is a single sentence with nothing after it, and echoing it into both fields makes the reader render the same words twice, which looks like a generator bug rather than like documentation. So a body with no remainder yields a summary and NOTHING else.
