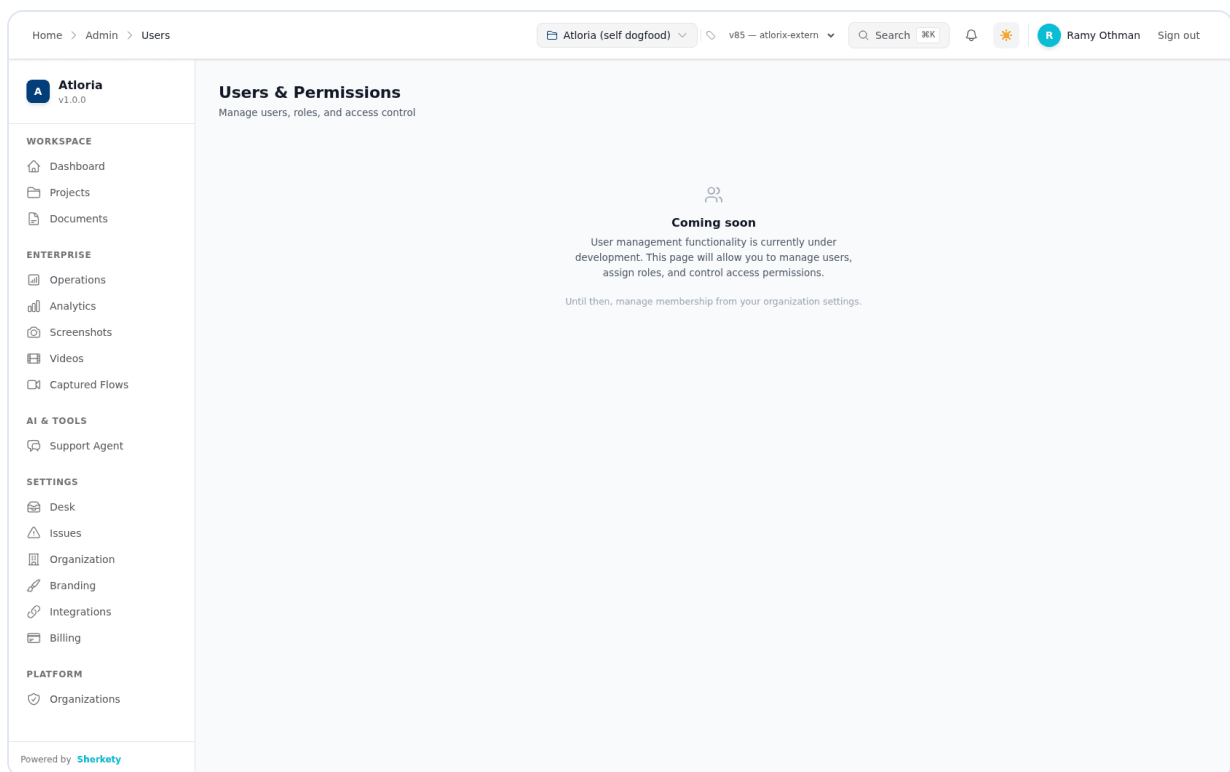
## Manage users
